
Color and cut out each of the eight squares below. Glue the squares in the correct order on the Pascha Week Timeline.



Then Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve disciples, went to the leading priests and asked, "How much will you pay me to betray Jesus to you?" And they gave him thirty pieces of silver. Matthew 26:14-15



Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a long linen cloth. He placed it in his own new tomb, which had been carved out of the rock. Then he rolled a great stone across the entrance as he left. Matthew 27:59-60



As they were eating, Jesus took a loaf of bread and asked God's blessing on it. Then he broke it in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, "Take it and eat it, for this is my body." Matthew 26:26



And seeing a fig tree by the road. He came to it and found nothing on it but leaves, and said to it, "Let no fruit grow on you ever again." Immediately the fig tree withered away. MATTHEW 21:19



Then the soldiers nailed him to the cross. Mark 15:24a



He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. JOHN 13:5
