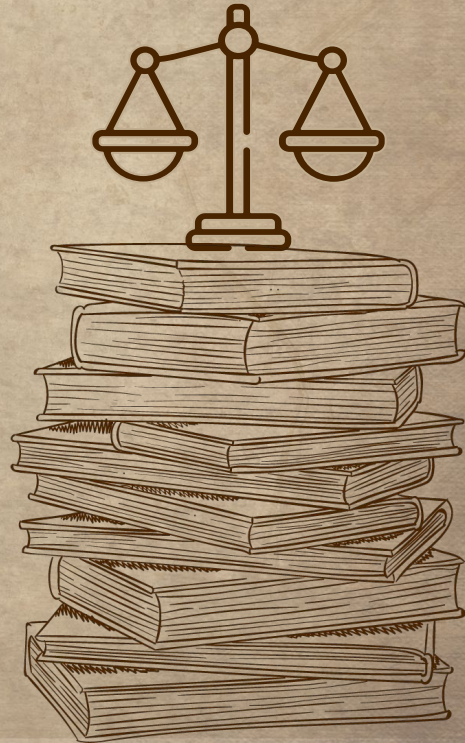
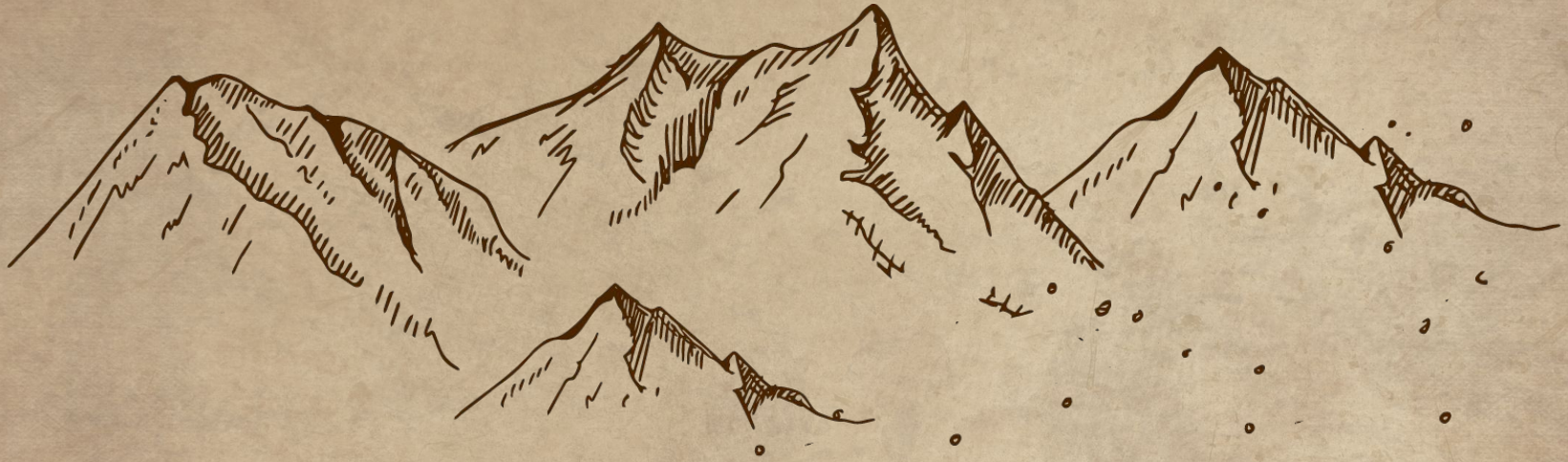

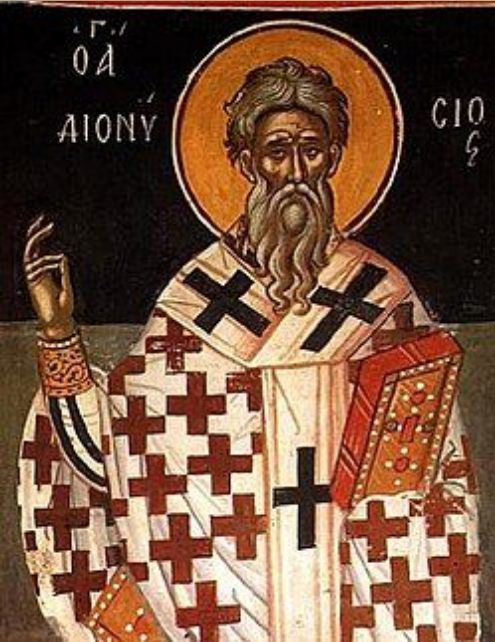


What does it mean to be

St. Timothy was known as “the poor” because he sold all his possessions and gave it to the poor (humility)

Through his wisdom he was able to prove Pope Athanasius’ innocence against false lies people were spreading

He was ordained a priest by Pope Athanasius, and was a teacher at the School of Alexandria. He eventually became the 22nd Pope

Second Council at Constantinople

PROBLEM

Three heretics Macedonius (the Patriarch of Constantinople), Sabilius, and Apollinarius were blaspheming against God the Word and the Holy Spirit



SOLUTION

They were **excommunicated** from the church. The **Creed** of faith was **completed** from “...Yes, we believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the Giver of Life...” to the end. And they wrote down many **cannons** (rules) that were needed for the church.
