
OLD TESTAMENT

- The book's purpose is to help us understand God's plan.
- God is the main character of the story. He is the same throughout the whole book.
- It took the longest time to write (From 1000 BC till 100 AD).
- 40 writers contributed in writing the book through the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- It includes two testaments, old and new












Israel is taken captive by the Assyrians (722 B.C.)

the Bible Prophets and Kings:

Most of the names are on this time line. But some prophets and kings were not around very long. So you won't see their names here.



Water clocks are used in Assyria to tell time



In Greece, people like songs about fights and wars



A big library is built in Nineveh



Around 600 B.C.

Nepuchagnezzar is king in Babylon

Babylon defeats Assyria (605 B.C.)

God's People

Esther becomes a queen in Persia

Ezra leads more of God's people back home

Around 450 B.C.

Nehemiah helps build the wall of Jerusalem back up

Around 590 B.C.

Babylon is overthrown by Persia, and Cyrus becomes king (539 B.C.)



A ship sails around Africa for the first time

In Persia, men riding horses carry messages back and forth
