A true coin that has value will have both heads and tails




Similarly, Feelings and Actions are 2 sides of True Love

Actions of Love! But these are a lot of actions!



How to Love action Plan (1) -

Hands On

Elders do a lot of work to keep young ones safe, healthy and happy. Kids can also show their love by participating in some of the work.

Examples of helping your elders:

Clean after yourself,

Get a drink for someone thirsty,

Wash the dishes,

Water the plants,

Wash the car,

Take care of your younger sibling,

Help grandpa/grandma find something that is lost,

Carry one of your teacher's bags if you see that she has too many things to carry,

Open the door for someone at church and let them in first,

Help Abouna find someone that he is looking for,

Give your seat away to an older person

And many more.....

Take advantage of your elder's need for an extra hand to show your love to them.

How to Love action Plan (2) -

Eyes & Mouth

Use your good eye. The good eye focuses on positives, like beauty, kindness, effort and anything that has been well done. Use your mouth and words to verbalize what you see.

Examples of appreciating your elders:

Mom, that is the best dinner ever! You always cook us yummy food!

Grandma, you look so pretty today, I love your dress!

Grandpa, thanks for your gift, I really enjoy it every day and my friends think it is so cool!

Teacher, you really explained this very well, I appreciate you as my teacher.

How to Love action Plan (3) -

Ears

Listening is loving. Obedience is the best way to show that you love your elders.

Examples of obeying your elders and caring for them:

Listen to learn, elders have lived longer than you so they have more experience and they want you to succeed

Listen because you care, ask Mom/Dad about their day, listen with genuine interest. Your care will help them feel better if they had a bad day

Listen to share your elders' sorrows and to celebrate their joys

Listen from the first time, slow obedience is disobedience

"My son, keep your father's command, and do not forsake the law of your mother." Proverbs 6:20

"Apply your heart to instruction, and your ears to words of knowledge." Proverbs 23:12

"Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right." Ephesians 6:1







How to Love action Plan (4) -

When things go wrong

Breathe deeply and remind yourself that everybody makes mistakes, including yourself. Our Lord Jesus asks us to always forgive.

Examples of reacting when things go wrong (using calm voice):

Mom, I didn't like that you put my toys away. Can we please agree on what I need to do so you don't have to do this again?

Grandma, I don't really enjoy the cooking channel that you've been watching. I know it's your favorite, but can I watch my show after you are done with yours?

Grandpa, I felt embarrassed when you were making a joke about my shirt. I know you were just being funny, but wanted you to know.

Teacher, I know you thought that I was talking in class when you punished me, but I wanted to clarify that I wasn't talking this time.











How to Love action Plan (5) -

Hugs & kisses

Absolutely! These are essential ingredients of love, but just giving hugs and kisses is not true love!

These are very special ingredients for the closest elders in your life like Mom, Dad, older siblings and other family members.

Examples:

Give Mom/Dad an extra squeeze before you run off to the playground. You will make their day.

Draw a card with hugs and kisses to a family member who lives out of the country.



"Then his father Isaac said to him, "Come near and kiss me, my son." So he came near and kissed him" Genesis 27:26-27




