- ✓ Say “No” to bullying.
- ✓ Volunteer to help someone
- ✓ Say “hi” to someone outside your usual social circle

“How to Love” Action Plan (2) - Eyes & Mouth

- ✓ Give compliments for the good things you see



Don't

- × Look and envy

“How to Love” Action Plan (3) - Ears

Do

- ✓ Be a good listener. Listening makes you understand others more. It shows your schoolmates your openness and your concern for them.

- × Gossip

Do

- ✓ Learn from what happened
- ✓ Move ahead

Don't

- × Attach more importance to the bad things that happen
- × Condemn or criticize
- × Try to get even with someone
- × Hold grudges
