

# Witnessing

Discuss the meaning of the two verses below then talk about how to serve the community and others.

- 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

“But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.”

- Matthew 5:14-16

“You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.”

Break the class into groups and give one picture to each group. Have them discuss within their group what services they can perform for their particular place. Please see attached photos of a hospital, seniors living assistance facility, church, soup kitchen, school, home. Each group should consist of at least three students. If there are not that many students then pick the pictures you want to use, and if there are an abundant number of students then put more in each group. After their discussion, bring everyone back together and have a representative from each group tell everyone about their list.
