

But the fruit of the Spirit is...



Gal. 5:22-23

Virtual Meeting:

Give them the above picture and ask each group of students or you can do this individually to locate the words of the verses in the picture, circle them, then write them in order. First group or person to complete the task wins.

In Person Meeting:

If meeting is in person, then I would suggest enlarging the verses, printing them out, cutting each word up separately, then hide the words in the classroom before the youth arrive to class. Make two sets or however many teams you want to have. Print each set on a different colored paper so each team knows what color they need to find. Once they find the words, then they must work as a team to put the verses back in order. The first team to assemble the verses wins. They cannot use their phones or bibles to remember the verses.

Do this activity at the end of the lesson and be sure to constantly repeat the verses so that they have it memorized before the activity begins.

Verses to print: "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law."
