- 2) Agpeya
- 3) Liturgy Book
- 4) Lafafa used in communion
- 5) Head covering
- 6) Communion cup for water
- 7) Bible
- 8) Picture of parents
- 9) Pen
- 10) Notebook
- 11) Blank white piece of paper in perfect condition

Whoever gathers the greatest number of items within 7 minutes wins. (Feel free to change the amount of time given to gather the items). After the items are gathered and everyone reassembles, then go over what each item represents in the list.

- 1) Heart is for the love you need to serve with.
- 2) The agpeya represents the prayers you need to be doing daily
- 3) The liturgy book, lafafa, head covering, and communion cup symbolizes the importance of attending liturgy on a regular basis.
- 4) Bible is the source of your material to teach and serve with.
- 5) Picture of your parents is for obedience as we must obey our parents as one of the ten commandants. The same is true for the service, we must have obedience to be successful. We must learn to obey our priests so that we may learn to obey our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 6) The pen and notebook are for confession. We must confess on a regular basis so that our service may be fruitful. If you are not continually improving your spiritual life and growing than how can you serve?
- 7) The blank, crisp, white piece of paper is for purity. Servants must strive for purity by examining their actions, repenting from wrongdoing, and confessing. They should not be making judgements or assumptions about those they serve.

Before providing the youth with the explanations, I would recommend asking them why they think they were asked to gather these items and what the think they represent.
