

For this exercise, select a passage from the Gospel's and have the students reflect on the following:

Ask yourselves always while reading: Who is God? What does what I am reading tell me about God?

- 1. Who is writing and to whom? What does it mean that it's written by them?
- 2. What am I reading? What is it saying? What is happening?
- 3. What does this mean about God's relationship with man?
- 4. What is the context of what is occurring?
- 5. Where is this happening in the context of God's relationship with man?
- 6. In the gospels, ask, Why is Christ saying what He is saying and approaching the situation in this way? What does this tell me about Him?
- 7. What is the cultural context, historical context?
- 8. What is everyone mentioned thinking? Why are thinking what they are thinking? What is their background?
- 9. Who is involved? How does who they are change the context of the situation?
- 10. What are the places mentioned? Does it make a difference in the story? Is there a reason the name of a place is mentioned? Is it a far place or a nearby neighbor?

Place yourself in the shoes of everyone mentioned

- 1. How would I react if someone told me this or did this to me?
- 2. How do I receive what God is telling this person (He may be talking to me as well)
- 3. How does Christ react to what is said and done to Him, or what is going on around Him? Do I react like Him? If not, why not? What do I need to do differently to start being more like Him?
- 4. Where is everyone in the situation? Are they inside, outside, by the side, just arriving? Does this change anything?
- 5. Why isn't Christ doing a particular thing or saying a particular thing?
- 6. When does Christ choose to speak and when does He stay silent? Why?
- 7. Why isn't a certain person doing a specific thing or saying something?
- 8. Are there any prophecies being fulfilled?
- 9. Why are certain people, places or things specifically mentioned and named?
- 10. How are people affected by their encounter with Jesus and God?
- 11. How can I apply this to my life? Where in my life can I start changing to be more inline with what I read? Where in my life can I start acting more like Christ?
